Dr S.K. Khatri, Addl Pro VC and Dean (Academics) presented SAP programme and streamlining, 3C programme student mapping and Joint/ Dual degrees, twinning programme credit identification.

The SAP courses have been developed in four domains across various international locations. Students of Amity are given choice to apply for the SAP courses for one semester or multiple semesters.

In addition to SAP programme university also offers 3C programmes wherein students can opt for studying in all three continents as per their choice.

University offers joint /dual degree programs in collaboration with prestigious foreign universities, allowing students to earn two degrees in academic journey. The guidelines and the modalities of flexibility have been provided to students and accordingly the students are guided by the Institutions and the International Affair Division (IAD). The details are given below:

- Twining Programmes: Students can earn 30% of their course credit at a foreign university and get the certificate but the degree will be provided by AUUP.
- Joint Degree Programmes: The collaborating institutions jointly design the curriculum and AUUP will provide the degree with logos of both the University. The credit units will be mutually decided as per the country and the requirements of both the universities as per the mapping of program-wise, course-wise curriculum.
- The calendar for all 3C Programmes and SAP will be streamlined and accordingly the academic process will be conducted.

### Remarks by External members

- a) Amity Alumni, Ms. Zeinia Samar, Sports Science, Olympic Gold Quest, who was present online, appreciated the efforts of the University and said that technology and innovation

are significantly transforming sports, influencing various aspects such as training methodologies, performance enhancement, student involvement, and equipment design. She gave three recommendations for integrating technology into sports programs at the academic or university level, aligning with current global standards:

- **Virtual Reality and Augmented Reality:** Utilizing VR and AR can greatly improve coaching and training by offering realistic practice environments that enhance decision-making skills.
  - **Motion Tracking and Biomechanical Analysis:** Implementing tools like force plates and motion analysis systems enables more precise training and rehabilitation programs.
  - **Wearable Technology:** Employing smartwatches and chest straps allows for the collection of vital fitness data, including heart rate, VO2 max, load monitoring, movement patterns, and sleep quality, thereby optimizing athletic performance.
- b) Amity Alumni, Ms Mansi Chaudhary, Founder & Managing Partner, The Frontiers Legal, New Delhi said that University should look for options and create awareness among students for schemes like scholarship, opportunities for fellowship, stipend provisions for B.Sc. and Biotech students. She also suggested that universities can develop an optional course on IPR in collaboration with IPR cell, which will enable students to pursue jobs in related areas like patenting officer, regulatory affairs etc.
- c) Mr. Alvin David, Head HR, Newgen Software Technologies Ltd, thanked the Chair and members for providing him with the opportunity to attend the meeting. He said that the industry is nowadays looking for problem solvers. He shared the concern that due to overindulgence in internet, the students today are lacking social skills and struggle to interact with clients. He also asked how the University is coping with plagiarism as students are used to using ChatGPT and other mediums for project writing and completing assignments.
- d) Mr. Rohan, AVP, WNS said that industry can offer cocurricular collaboration with Amity and offer one year internships to B Tech students.
- e) Mr. David proposed that Newgen would like to launch a focused BTech for limited students (20 only) and would like to interact with concerned university officers.

## **The following discussions took place based on the above industry concerns:**

- a) The Chair stated that Amity does have collaboration with industry like Tata Technologies, RICS, etc, wherein courses are divided such that every year the percentage of courses with industry is as per the mutual agreement. Also, our engagement with Industry should lead to classroom learning, projects, research, student development which will automatically lead to placement. The specialization courses can be offered by various industry in the same subject.
- b) Addl Pro Vice Chancellor and Dean (Academics) also added that industry requirements are converted into projects, courses and specialization courses, etc., and the students can opt them accordingly. For example, Wipro visited the campus for placement and during the discussions briefed us about their requirements. Taking this as feedback, we are

developing courses / projects as per the student preference. Such collaborations can be made with other organizations also.

Action to be taken:

Dr Chanderdeep Tandon, Addl Pro Vice Chancellor and Dean Biosciences and Biotechnology along with his domain institutions must benchmark themselves with top Biotechnology Institutions both International and National.

A brainstorming meeting with Alumni of Biotech Domain to be arranged before making the strategy for placement for the year 2025-2026.

## Remarks by University IQAC members

- a) Dr D P Singh, Dean Faculty of Architecture, Planning & Interior Design said that the website should be designed so that it is user friendly. He also said that the analysis of feedback should be directed towards FDPs. Dr Singh also mentioned that since the subjects of Architecture are of high credit courses, the duration of the classes is longer, and faculty does not get enough slots.
- b) Dr Rekhā Agarwal said that in order to achieve 100% progression, we should focus on the training as per student's aspirations.
- c) Dr V Pooja shared that the UIQAC meeting has given the understanding of working of all other domains, which is part of great learning in the areas of progression academics, research and adding value to the institution.
- d) Dr Roopali Sharma, Professor AIPS said that the E-content of the leaving faculty is not visible to the students as well as new faculty assigned.
- e) Dr M. Sajnani, Dean Faculty of Hospitality & Tourism said that whenever MoU is signed with any foreign university it should be in knowledge of other institutions, so that they can also search the possibilities of MoUs for their courses, it should not be bound to few courses only. Also, the collaborations should not be restricted to programmes and student exchange only, it should also include other areas such as projects, research publications, etc.
- f) Dr Shukla informed that Registrar has developed a system on Amizone where all the MoUs signed are visible on the Amizone, so that other departments can also take the initiative to collaborate with.
- g) Dr H P Singh, Dean Student Welfare announced that a Student Support Welfare fund will be available for the Institutions/Domains for various events like Fresher Party, Farewell, Club Committee activities, Inter Institutional competition, Festivals, Fests, etc. This fund will be taken along with the semester fee.

## Decisions taken:

- a) Dr S K Khatri, Addl Pro Vice Chancellor and Dean (Academics), Dr D P Singh, Dean Faculty of Architecture, Planning & Interior Design and Mr. Senthil Kumar, Sr Vice President AKC Data Systems to give the proposal to make the website more user friendly.
- b) The Faculty of Architecture, Planning & Interior Design and Real Estate Institutions (RICS) to have a meeting together and develop high quality 2 FDPS in the month of June 2025 wherein all civil, architecture, computational design and real estate faculties of the Amity Group will be participating.
- c) The classes can be conducted for zero hours and faculty working hours can be flexible. Also, if a faculty is taking classes on Saturday, weekly off can be given on other days. Summer internship calendar will be uniform for all the institutions.

- d) Dr Sanjeev Bansal, Addl Pro Vice Chancellor, Dr Alpana Kakar, Dean (SS & AA) and Dr Sujata Khandai, Dy Dean (Academics) to develop and design feedback from course faculty about each student which they have taught.
- e) The e-content of the leaving faculty should be visible to the Students, Head of Institution as well as new faculty assigned.

## **Closing remarks by The Chairperson:**

The Chairperson stated that Members of University IQAC are giving valuable inputs. She emphasised that all members should be well prepared before the IQAC meetings so that all can contribute towards the improvement and quality enhancement in AUUP.

The Chairperson told the members that Amity centre for Artificial Intelligence has proposed to conduct training workshops on how to integrate AI for various Academic and Academic Administrative functions. These workshops will be conducted in following groups:

- a) AI training for Deans, Head of Institutions, Centre Heads and Heads of Department for Academic Administration.
- b) AI training for faculty to integrate AI in teaching learning process.
- c) AI training for non-teaching staff.
- d) Each domain to conduct AI training by external domain experts (like Biotech, law) and how they have utilized AI in their work.
- e) AI training for non-teaching staff will also be conducted.
- f) Special workshop to be conducted by Addl PVC & Dean Academic and Addl PVC & Dean FMS for assessment part.

The Chair further announced that Annual Academic Planning 2025-26 will be discussed in next University IQAC meeting.

The dates of the next 29<sup>th</sup> University IQAC were announced by the Officiating Registrar as 9 - 10 June 2025 and 17-18 June 2025.

## **Conclusion**

The Vice Chancellor thanked all the members of the University IQAC and Officers of the University for their significant contribution and active participation.
